BEFORE COMING TO THE SALE:

1) Please bring your class schedule and 2018-2019 textbook list--**We will not have extra copies to hand out**
In mid-July class schedules will be mailed home and the 2018-2019 textbook list will be posted on the school's website

2) Make a list of the specific books you would like to purchase at the sale
*The school is not responsible for lost books or for the purchase of outdated or unusable books. **ALL SALES ARE FINAL***

3) Find and bring a large box/bag to carry your books—**No Backpacks allowed into the sale**

NEW THIS YEAR/IMPORTANT:

1. Payments via Cash or Checks only-NO CREDIT CARDS WILL BE ACCEPTED.

***CASH**-please bring small bills. We are unable to make change. **CHECK**-checks are made out to the individual seller. You may end up writing several checks*

2. PICK-UP cash and checks and any unsold textbooks-SAME DAY AS SALE 1:00pm-3pm in Cannon Commons

Shop the sale and then return between 1:00pm and 3:00pm to pick up your checks and any unsold textbooks. Money not picked up by 3:00pm ON July 25th will be held in the Business Office. No money will be mailed to students.

3. MUHS is unable to store any unclaimed books

Unclaimed books that are not picked up by 3:00pm on July 25th will be disposed of. No Exceptions.

Students should have all their books and supplies by the first day of school, August 22nd. If you cannot find a book at the Used Book Sale, you can purchase new and used books through the official MUHS bookstore managed by K12Student Direct.
