

## MATH PLACEMENT & COURSE SELECTION



### Curriculum & Requirements

At a minimum, Marquette requires all students to successfully complete Algebra 1, Geometry, and Algebra 2 for graduation. All students should be aware of the mathematics requirements of the college or university they hope to attend and the requirements for their particular field of interest.



### Course Selection Information

Previous Math Achievement	Typical Placement
Middle school pre-algebra <u>OR</u> HSPT score is below 70%	Algebra 1
If a student has taken algebra in middle school + scores at the 70 <sup>th</sup> percentile on the HSPT <u>OR</u> scores above 50% on the MUHS Math Placement test	Honors Algebra 1 and 2
If a student has taken algebra in middle school + scores at the 90 <sup>th</sup> percentile on the HSPT <u>OR</u> scores above 70% on the MUHS Math Placement test	Honors Geometry and Algebra 2
If a student has taken Geometry transcribed by an accredited high school <u>OR</u> has taken Geometry at their grade school + passes the MUHS Geometry Test	AP Precalculus+



### Course Placement Information

- Preliminary mathematics course placements are made early in the spring semester based on the students' applications and HSPT scores. You can find your placement in Skyward.
- The mathematics placement test takes place in late April. The placement test is not required if families and students are satisfied with their preliminary placement.
- Updated course placements are sent to families after students take the MUHS Mathematics Placement Test.
