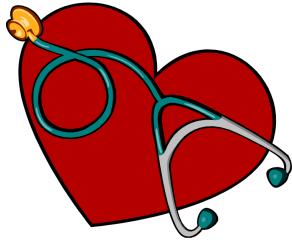

September 14- Acceptance & Serenity

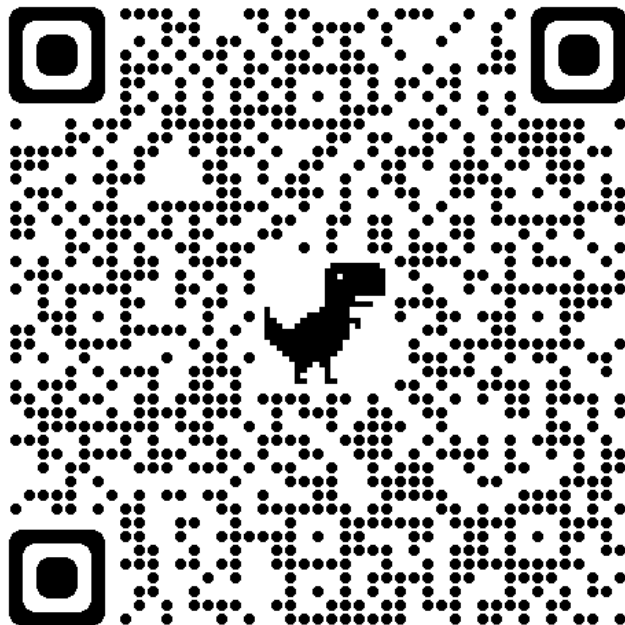
September 21- Spirituality & Mental Health
