

## CLASS OF 2022 – FINAL TIPS & REMINDERS

### YOUR FINAL MUHS TRANSCRIPT TO YOUR DESTINATION COLLEGE:

Your final MUHS transcript, showing verification of graduation, will be sent by June 15th to the college that you will be attending as reported to College Counseling. You do not need to place a request or pay a fee for this final transcript. Every college requires an official final transcript for enrolling freshmen as colleges will hold financial aid disbursement and course registration if a final transcript is not received. **Please note: Final transcripts will be held and not released to your chosen college until all MUHS fees are paid.**

**IMPORTANT:** If you have not yet chosen your destination college OR if you make a change to the college decision you told to our office, please email Ms. Sahagún at [sahagun@muhs.edu](mailto:sahagun@muhs.edu) with your final decision.

### ACT OR SAT SCORES TO YOUR DESTINATION COLLEGE:

If you chose to include your ACT or SAT scores for your college admission review and you self-reported your scores on your CommonApp, we anticipate you are now being asked (required) by your chosen college to submit your **official** ACT or SAT score. An official score means your score is sent directly from the testing agency (ACT or SAT) to your college. Remember, sending scores is a student's responsibility and you do this through your test account.

### SLU (Dual Enrollment) 1818 TRANSCRIPT TO YOUR DESTINATION COLLEGE:

For those of you who enrolled in SLU1818 Dual Enrollment course(s), a reminder to request your official SLU transcript be sent to your chosen college for transfer credit review/award. As your destination college will need a posted course grade(s) on your SLU transcript to review your course(s) for transfer credit, if you are taking a dual enrollment course *this spring 2022 semester*, St. Louis University suggests you wait to order your official transcript until your current semester grade(s) is posted on your SLU transcript (around mid-June). You can "View Your Unofficial Transcript" to verify your spring grade(s) is posted and order your official transcript from the [SLU TRANSCRIPT REQUEST WEBSITE](#) **BEFORE YOU BEGIN...MAY WE RECOMMEND:** Check out SLU's "[Learn How To Request a Transcript](#)", a step-by-step guide on how to order a transcript.

### YOUR MUHS EMAIL EXPIRATION DATE:

The MUHS IT Team is very gracious to support your continued connection to MUHS. **Your MUHS email address will remain active for one full year from graduation and will expire on June 1, 2023.** We encourage you to please use the coming months to shift your primary email contact to a personal (Gmail, etc.) or college email address.

A short email to the college's general admissions email address sharing your request to withdraw your application is all that is needed. Your application withdrawal can help a college manage a freshman waiting list and letting them know you have decided to attend another college is respectful and appreciated (and it will keep your Inbox and Voicemails free from their reminders).
